About a year ago, on March the 7th 2009, the CEE Foundation held its 2nd annual fundraiser in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (USA). In my opening speech, I invited guests to take up on the challenge of equipping the Institute of Technology of Cambodia (ITC) in Phnom Penh with a computer lab, to build a bridge between young students — eager to learn new skills — and the Cambodia's Information Technology's of tomorrow.

The fundraiser was a success that evening, and later on, contributors from other states and from Canada helped make the ITC Computer Lab an even closer reality .

A few months after that event, 31 computers and accessories were ordered and local craftsmen were contacted to build tables and chairs for the lab.
