

Education Development Program (EDP)

The purpose of the EDP is to provide financial assistant and/other means to a broader area of Cambodian education beside the Scholarship Program. At the present time, the EDP is a wish list. One or more items below may be implemented if resource becomes available and with the Board of Directors approval. It is intended that the EDP is funded by an Education Development Fund. Like the Special Scholarship Fund, the donor specifies that the monies are to be used for a particular program. The local CEE Foundation may do a fundraising just to benefit any specific program.

The order of the following does not indicate the priority or the importance of the program.

School Building Program

This program is to build new school (elementary or high school) or one or more school buildings in any rural areas as specified by the donor. In case the donor does not specify the region, the Board of Directors will decide.

School Supplies Program

This program is to provide school supplies to any school in any rural areas as specified by the donor. In case the donor does not specify the school, the Board of Directors will decide.

Teacher Assistant Program

This program is to supplement salary to teachers in any rural areas of the donor choice. In case the donor does not specify the teacher, the Board of Directors will decide.

College Dormitory Program

This program is to build dormitory for college students. The dormitory will house any college students who meet our stringent criteria or may charge a minimum rental for maintenance and administration.

Student Exchange Program

In this program, the CEE Foundation will facilitate the exchange of students between the universities or colleges in the United States, Canada, France and other countries and the universities or colleges in Cambodia. The foundation will look for students or group of students who are willing to go and live in Cambodia for a certain period of time to study a certain areas including, but not limited to, Khmer language, Khmer culture, etc. We will charge a fee for the arrangement. The foundation will also look for universities or colleges wanting to take Cambodian students to study in a certain area of study for free.

Computer Literacy Program

This program is to provide computer equipments along with software required to schools and libraries in Cambodia.

Young Writers Program

This program is to encourage young Cambodian to write responsibly to strengthen the moral and self-confidence in the Cambodian society. The foundation would like to create an Academy to recognize, accredit, and to give the award of recognition to the writers whose works meet criteria above.
