Eligibility & Qualification Criteria

Cambodian students who:

- Have achieved academic excellence
- Are from impoverished background
- Are not related to CEE Foundation Selecting Committee members
- Have not received substantial support from other individuals or organizations
- Have shown the following qualities:
 - Trustworthiness
 - Responsibility
 - Respect
 - Citizenship
- Will attend a Cambodian educational institution full time
- Will maintain academic excellence
- Provide three letters of recommendation from immediate teachers and person not related to the applicant
- Submit a 2,000-word essay about the decision to attend college and future career goals
- Provide CEE Foundation with academic updates at the end of every semester
- Meet other criteria as defined by CEE Foundation.

- Create a general scholarship fund for higher education.
- Create a special scholarship fund for students who meet criteria as specified by particular individuals or groups of donors.
- Create an educational development fund for assistance other than scholarships.

Fact

“In 2005, out of 47,870 students who took the Baccalaureate high school exam, 34,174 (71%) passed the exam, but only 2,412 (7%) received a scholarship to pursue higher education.” †

In 2007, 30 scholarships have been awarded. Our scholarship provisions are projected as follows:

In 2008

Award at least 100 scholarships, each with

- \$100.00 for books
- \$200.00 for food and lodging

In 2009 and Beyond

Award at least 100 scholarships per year, each with

- \$150.00 or more for books
- \$300.00 or more for food and lodging
